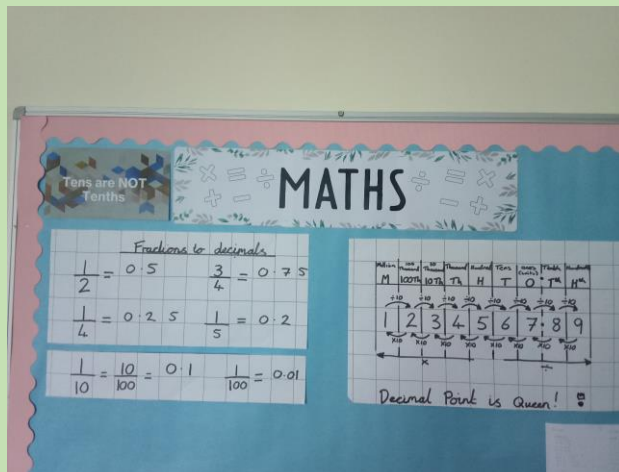
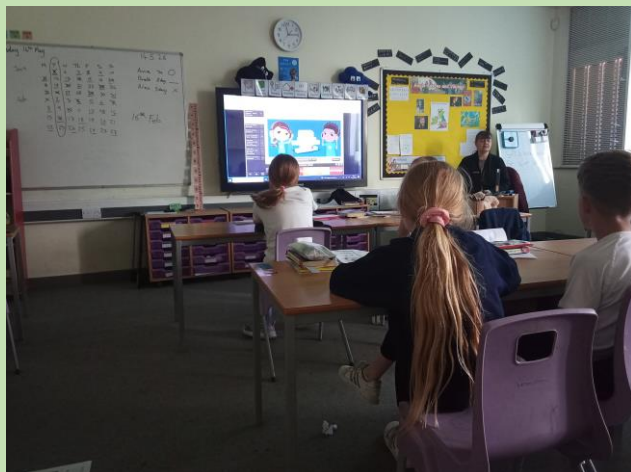
With it being SATs week the Year 4s have shown great maturity and compassion for the Year 6s and worked hard to give them a peaceful environment to take their SATs.
